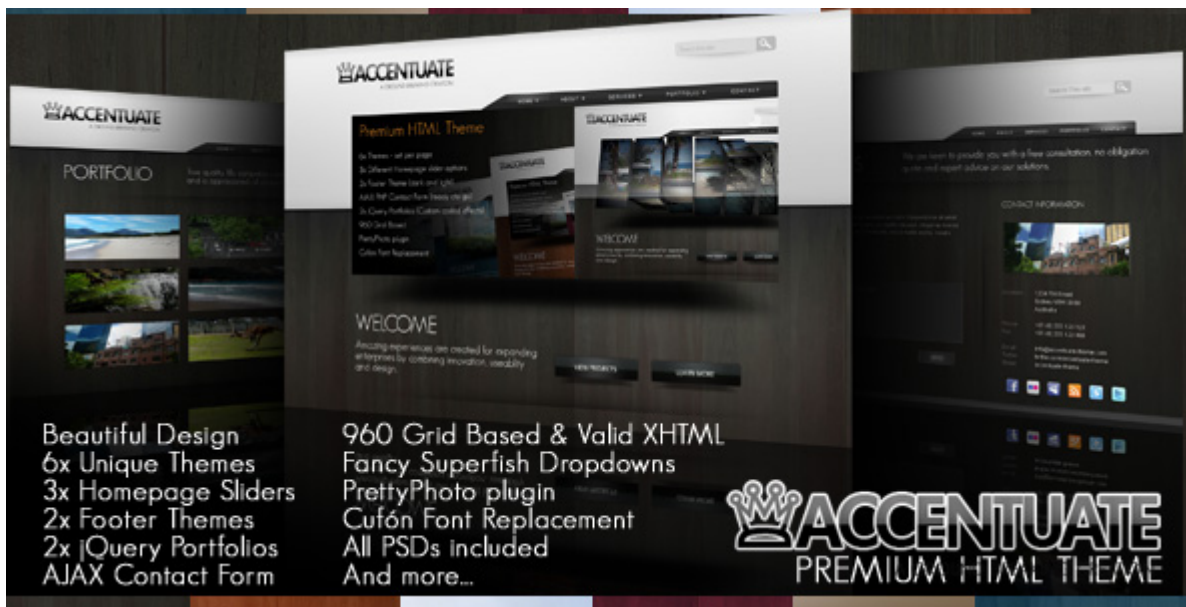


ACCENTUATE HTML THEME



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HOMEPAGE SLIDERS

This theme comes ready with 3 different sliders:

1. 3D PieceMaker (flash)
2. GlideSlider (jQuery)
3. NivoSlider (jQuery)

PIECEMAKER

The home page with the 3D Cu3er is the default home page, called **index.html**

There are many settings and customizations which can be done to the slider. Everything is controlled from the **piecemakerXML.xml** file. For instructions on customizing the 3D PieceMaker see: [piecemaker_documentation.pdf](#)

GLIDESLIDER

The home page with the GlideSlider is called **index-glideSlider.html**

The HTML for the slider looks like this:

There must be a link in the **paging** div for each image in the **#slider** div above.

I.e if there is 5 images in the **#slider** div then you must have 6 links in the **paging** div below.

The 6th paging link would look like this:

```
<a href="#" rel="7">7</a>
```

The speed of the slider can be changed in the **js/custom.js** file. Look for:

```

The **3000** = 3 second delay, you can change this to whatever number you want and it will determine the delay of each slide. Don't change anything else unless you know what you're doing ☺

NIVOSLIDER

The home page with the NivoSlider home page is called **index-nivoSlider.html**

The code is simple for the NivoSlider, you can add as many slides as you like, just follow the way it has been done.

You can remove the link tags if you do not want to make the slides clickable.

PORTFOLIO

VIDEOS

You can easily make the Portfolio open videos, not just images. Just link to the video from the link tag. Tested with YouTube and Vimeo videos. Here are examples of the code for images and videos:

IMAGE:

```
<div class="thumb"><a href="images/portfolio/portfolio_7.jpg" rel="prettyPhoto" title="Waterfront, Tasmania"></a></div>
```

VIDEO (YOUTUBE):

```
<div class="thumb"><a href="http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=1RTiUbUjVTU" rel="prettyPhoto"
title="Melbourne, Victoria"></a></div>
```

VIDEO (VIMEO)

```
<div class="thumb"><a href="http://vimeo.com/7161981&width=700" rel="prettyPhoto" title="Wine Glass Bay,
Tasmania"></a></div>
```

THUMBNAILS

You can use the portfolio_thumb.psd file in the skinning folder to create perfect size thumbnails.

CONTACT FORM

Setting up the contact is super easy. All you need to do is add your email address.

In contact.php find:

```
$mail_To = "email@accentuate-theme.com";
```

Replace the email@accentuate-theme.com with your own email address, save and you're done.

You can also customize the message the user sees after a message has been sent.

Find:

```
<p class="success">Thank you, your message has been successfully sent</p>
```

And replace it with whatever you like.

SWITCHING THEMES

To change the theme of a page, simply add the related class to the body tag of that page.

FOR EXAMPLE, BY DEFAULT THE INDEX PAGE BODY TAG IS LIKE THIS:

```
<body>
```

To apply the woody theme to this page simply add class="woody" into the body tag. So the final result is like this:

```
<body class="woody">
```

Here is a list of the different themes. They are the classes which you can add to the body tags of any pages to apply:

- bluewood
- choc
- royal
- skyblue
- woody
- (default is without any extra classes in the body tag)

EXAMPLE FOR A CONTENT PAGE: APPLYING THE ROYAL THEME

Step 1. Open the page you want to apply the theme to.

Step 2. Add the royal class to the body tag.

Find:

```
<body class="content">
```

Replace with:

```
<body class="content royal">
```

Step 3. Save and you're done.

NB: By controlling the theme with a class, you can easily use different themes for different pages, all on the same site.

SWITCHING THE FOOTER

You can have either a light footer or a dark footer on each page. By default the footer is dark. To make the footer on a page light, simply add the white class to the `footer_bg` div on that page.

CHANGING THE FOOTER

Step 1: Open the page you want to change and Find, `<div class="footer_bg">`

Step 2. Add white inside the class, so it will be like this: `<div class="footer_bg white">`

Tip: if you want to replace the footer on all pages, do a find and replace for the entire site:

FIND:

```
<div class="footer_bg">
```

REPLACE WITH:

```
<div class="footer_bg white">
```

NB: By controlling the footer with a class, you can easily use different footer colours for different pages, all on the same site.

PSD FILES

Clean PSD files are included. The two main PSD files are: **main.psd** and **layouts.psd**. **main.psd** is the main homepage layout with complete un-rasterized layers. For the layouts.psd file I have merged the background theme layers because the file size was so huge. You are welcome to contact me if you want the uncompressed version and I'll gladly arrange to send it to you.

home-header.psd is for you to create more image headers for the home page slides, located in /images/header/.

portfolio_thumb.psd is a model for you to create your portfolio thumbnails. The thumbnails display smaller and then pop-out when you hover on them, I recommend you stay with these pre-set size.
